

# STADIUM GUIDE

## CASHLESS TRANSACTIONS

To reduce and avoid contact between cash and food/retail handling, all Yankee Stadium retail food and beverage locations will be cashless and will only accept credit/debit cards, advanced purchases, and touchless payments. Additionally, mobile ordering and pick up through Uber Eats will be available at select stands on the Field, Main and Terrace Levels. For Guests who wish to pay with cash, cash conversion stations (i.e., reverse ATM machines) will be available in the Great Hall at Section 110, at Section 128, at Section 223 and at Section 320C, issuing no-fee, prepaid debit cards starting at \$1 minimum denomination. The prepaid debit card can be used at any food or retail location inside the Stadium. Any remaining funds left on the prepaid debit card can be used anywhere that Mastercard is accepted.

## ENTRY AND CARRY-IN POLICY

**NOTICE:** For the safety of every Guest, all persons specifically consent to and are subject to metal detector and physical pat-down inspections prior to entry. Any item or property that could affect the safety of Yankee Stadium, its occupants or its property shall not be permitted into the Stadium. Any person that could affect the safety of the Stadium, its occupants or its property shall be denied entry. For security reasons, each Guest is permitted to bring into Yankee Stadium only one MLB-compliant bag – presently defined by Major League Baseball as soft-sided and no larger than 16 inches by 16 inches by 8 inches – and only one smaller-sized soft-sided personal item (e.g., a handbag, clutch, tote or plastic grocery bag). All hard-sided bags and containers are strictly prohibited. All MLB-compliant bags, personal items and their contents are subject to a physical search and/or X-ray screening before they are permitted into the Stadium. **Please note: There is no storage area for any items at Yankee Stadium.** For more information regarding the entry and carry-in policy, please visit [yankees.com](http://yankees.com). Re-entry is not permitted. Please note security regulations may be amended at any time.

## EXIT/RE-ENTRY

**Guests are not permitted to leave Yankee Stadium and return on the same ticket.** Re-entry will be permitted only in the case of an emergency. In the event of an emergency, please see security personnel prior to exiting the Stadium.

## PEPSI GAME-DAY MESSAGES

## GATE LOCATIONS AND OPENINGS

Yankee Stadium has four gate locations for entry and exit:

- Gate 2, adjacent to left field: Enter via Jerome Avenue and East 164th Street
- Gate 4, behind home plate: Enter via East 161st Street and Macombs Dam Bridge
- Gate 6, adjacent to right field: Enter via East 161st Street and River Avenue
- Gate 8, adjacent to center field: Enter via River Avenue and 164th Street

For New York City FC matches, gates will open 90 minutes prior to the scheduled start time of the match. For the New Era Pinstripe Bowl game, gates will open two hours prior to the scheduled start time of the game, subject to change.

Please note that gate openings for all other public events will be announced as the date(s) for those events approach. Gate openings are subject to change during inclement weather and for special events, doubleheaders, Opening Day, the Old-Timers' Day game and postseason play or at Yankee Stadium management's discretion. There may be a point during a game, match or event when Guests may only enter through the Yankee Stadium Lobby, adjacent to Gate 2.

## HEALTH AND SAFETY GUIDELINES

Yankee Stadium's health and safety requirements are constantly changing in line with local and national directives. Please check [www.yankees.com/updates](http://www.yankees.com/updates) for the most up-to-date information.

The number of innings in a regulation game shall be determined by Major League Baseball and may be shortened in accordance with Major League Baseball rules. The Yankees make no representation, warranty and/or guarantee that nine (9) innings will be played in any regulation game.

The number of games in a regular season shall be determined by Major League Baseball. The Yankees make no representation, warranty and/or guarantee that a regular season will be comprised of eighty-one (81) home games.

Please note that protective netting of varying heights is located between Section 011 on the first base/right-field side of the Stadium and continues to Section 029 on the third base/left-field side of the Stadium.

**WARNING:** For the safety of everyone in Yankee Stadium, all Guests must stay alert and be aware of their surroundings at all times, as during all batting practices, fielding practices and warm-ups and throughout the course of all baseball games and the baseball game experiences, hard-hit baseballs and bats and fragments thereof may be thrown or hit into the stands, concourses, walkways, concessions areas, Monument Park and all other publicly accessible areas within the Stadium. Further, Guests concerned with their original ticketed location by reason of the foregoing should, at any time before or during the baseball game or the baseball game experiences, proceed to the Guest Relations Booth, located adjacent to Gate 6 in the Great Hall or the Yankee Stadium Ticket Window, located adjacent to the Yankees Team Store behind home plate in the Great Hall; however, please remember that: (a) any requested relocation is subject to availability; (b) any alternate seat or standing location may be in a section and/or level of the Stadium and/or within a price category that is not in the same section and/or level and/or price category of the Guests' original ticketed location, regardless of their original ticketed location; and (c) any Guest requesting relocation is responsible for paying the incremental price increase, if any, of the ticket price for the available alternate location. Relocation to a seat or standing location at a lower price than the price of the original ticketed location will not result in a refund or credit.

## LOST AND FOUND

Anyone wishing to turn in a found item or inquire about a lost item may do so at the Guest Relations and Ticket Sales Booth, adjacent to Gate 6 in the Great Hall, or at the Yankee Stadium Lobby, adjacent to Gate 2. To inquire via phone, please call (718) 579-4413. Lost items turned in to Yankee Stadium management will be held at the Stadium for 10 days before being relinquished in accordance with New York State law.

## MONUMENT PARK

Monument Park, located in center field, recognizes legends who have appeared at Yankee Stadium over the years. On game days, it opens with the gates and remains accessible for Guests' enjoyment until 45 minutes prior to the scheduled start time of the game (subject to strict capacity limitations). Please note that the line to Monument Park may close earlier than the Park itself. Signage directs Guests to Monument Park. Yankee Stadium Team Members are also available to assist Guests.

## NEW YORK YANKEES MUSEUM presented by

Ticketed Guests (subject to strict capacity limitations) can enjoy the museum free of charge when gates open until the end of the eighth inning for Yankees home games. Other exceptions to this do apply. Guests can also experience the museum as part of Yankee Stadium tours.

## NURSING MOTHERS

A mother may nurse her child in any public location where she is comfortable. Nursing mothers seeking more discreet accommodations are welcome to use the dedicated space in the Plymouth Rock® Kids Clubhouse, subject to availability.

## SMOKING POLICY

Smoking, including the use of electronic cigarettes, is prohibited in Yankee Stadium. There are no designated smoking areas, and re-entry is prohibited. The use of smokeless tobacco is also prohibited. Violators will be ejected immediately without refund and may face possible revocation of season tickets and/or future ticket privileges.

**NOTICE:** The Yankees reserve the right, with or without refunding any amount paid by the ticket holder, to refuse admission to and/or eject any person who: (a) is or appears to be impaired; (b) conceals alcohol, illegal substances and/or other prohibited items while attempting to enter Yankee Stadium; (c) acts in a manner that is unruly, disruptive or illegal; (d) uses derogatory, foul and/or abusive language and/or gestures; (e) displays and/or wears and fails to cover obscene, indecent and/or inappropriate clothing; (f) exposes him/herself; (g) otherwise violates the Stadium's Code of Conduct, ordinances, rules, requirements, directives, regulations; or (h) interferes with any ball in the field of play or any sports or event participant attempting to make a play on any batted, pitched or thrown baseball. Ticket holders acknowledge and agree that the Yankees' ban on derogatory, foul and/or abusive language and/or gestures and obscene, indecent and/or inappropriate clothing (i.e., clauses (d) through (f) above) does not violate their right to free speech and/or expression and that such time, place and manner of the restrictions are reasonable to maintain a family-friendly atmosphere for minors, ensure the safety of all Guests and sports or event participants, and preserve the enjoyment of the game or event for all Guests. In addition, ticket holders further acknowledge and agree that by entering the Stadium, they hereby consent to the ban on derogatory, foul and/or abusive language and/or gestures and obscene, indecent and/or inappropriate clothing and waive, to the fullest extent they may legally and effectively do so, any objection they may now or hereafter have to such ban and the penalties that the Yankees may impose for any violation of the same.
